Applications are invited from qualified candidates who wish to be considered for appointment as Heritage Technical Officer at the National Heritage Fund (NHF), a statutory body under the aegis of the Ministry of Arts and Culture.

II. Age Limit

Candidates, unless already in service, should not have reached their <u>45th</u> birthday by the closing date for the submission of applications.

III. Qualifications

Candidates should possess:

- **A.** A Cambridge Higher School Certificate or Passes in at least two subjects obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education "Advanced Level"
- **B.** A diploma from a recognized institution in one of the following subjects:
 - (i) Archaeology
 - (ii) History
 - (iii) Architecture
 - (iv) Anthropology
 - (v) Heritage Studies
 - (vi) Social Work

Or

Equivalent qualifications to A and B above acceptable to the Board.

C. Candidates should also –

- (i) demonstrate an active interest in the historical evolution of Mauritius and the Mauritian heritage;
- (ii) possess good communication and interpersonal skills; and
- (iii) be computer literate.

Experience in fieldwork and research is desirable.

Qualification at A above should have been obtained prior to qualification at B above.

Candidates should produce written evidence of knowledge/experience claimed.

IV. Duties and Salary

- 1. To assist in the identification, safeguard and management of tangible and intangible heritage.
- 2. To undertake research, carry out fieldwork and gather information on heritage issues.
- 3. To assist in the preparation of reports on projects related to heritage.
- 4. To assist in the enforcement of legislation relating to heritage.
- 5. To liaise with the Manager Technical Section and relevant authorities/bodies in respect of technical issues relating to heritage projects.
- 6. To make use of information and communication technology in the performance of his duties.
- 7. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Heritage Technical Officer in the roles ascribed to him.
